The following entitlements will be reported via unit diary on all Marines deploying to **AFGHANISTAN**

- Deployed Per Diem: \$3.50/Day = ~\$105/Month
- Imminent Danger Pay (IDP): \$7.50/Day = \$225/Month
- Hardship Duty Pay Location (HDP-L): \$100 a month
- Hardship Duty Pay Tempo (HDP-T): \$16.50/Day = ~\$495/Month
 - 221+ days of service in HDP location
 - MarAdmin 574/16 (Expires 30 Sept 17)
- Family Separation Allowance (FSA-T): \$250/Month
 - Marines with dependents only
- Basis Allowance for Subsistence (BAS)
 - Enlisted: ~\$370/Month
 - Officers: ~\$250/Month
- Combat Zone Tax Exclusion (CZTE)

Approximate Totals Enlisted: (S) \$800 + CZTE Enlisted: (D) \$1050 + CZTE Officers: (S) \$680 + CZTE Officers: (D) \$970 + CZTE

2-3 Paychecks before Pay/Allowances fully processed





SAVINGS DEPOSIT PROGRAM



- Available only to those serving in designated combat zones.
- May deposit all or part of their un-allotted pay into a DOD savings account up to \$10,000 during a single deployment. Savings Deposit Program (SDP) allows members to earn ten percent interest per year, compounded quarterly (2.5% per quarter).
 - Although federal income earned in hazardous duty zones is tax-free, interest accrued on earnings deposited into the SDP is taxable.
- **Process:** DD 2558 filled out and submitted to IPAC via J-1.
- Withdrawal: Withdrawal of deposits may be requested 90 days after entitlement to IDP terminates (Automatic).

 - Rank, Name, Branch of Service, SSN, Information about deployed unit, Name/Contact for immediate family, Where emergency can be verified (Hospital/Doctor)
- **Does not guarantee Emergency Leave**





- Notification: Handled by HQMC Casualty **Branch**
 - Death: In Person (If multiple NOK identified, done at same time)
 - SI/VSI: Done via telephone
- Casualty Assistance Calls Officer (CACO)
 - SNCO/Officer assigned by HQMC
 - Assist the family
 - Mortuary Affairs
 - Funeral-related activities
 - Apply for benefits







- Entitlements
 - SGLI: \$400,000
 - Death Gratuity: \$100,000 (Assist w. immediate living expenses of Marine)
 - Invitational Travel Orders (ITO)
 - Funeral Expenses
 - Arrears of Pay & Allowances
